Catalog Addenda Revised Admission Requirements

Effective 9/22/2003

Candidates for admission must meet one of the following criteria:

- the applicant has a high school diploma from a United States secondary school or an equivalent credential from a foreign educational system;
- the applicant has a General Education Development (GED) diploma; or
- the applicant receives passing scores on a federally approved entrance examination that demonstrates that the student can benefit from the education being offered.

In rare instances, foreign high school graduates whose records are not obtainable may be admitted on the basis of examinations administer by the College which show the ability of such students to succeed in college-level studies. In addition, admission of these applicants cannot occur until documentation is obtained that indicates that a reasonable attempt has been made by the student to secure the secondary school records in question.
